Agenda Topics

Recap on OPEN Review – Neesha Desai discussed the due dates for the OPEN review

CTSU AE Review Update – Tina Taylor announced that the NCI co-leads have accepted the comments from CTSU for the AE recommendations. There were no major changes from CTSU.

OPEN Implementation Workflow – Neesha Desai provided a list of assumptions for the OPEN Implementation Workflow. Ginger walked through the OPEN Implementation Workflow

- This process workflow is only specific to the implementation of the OPEN content. The
 process will be modified based on the set of content.
- Process includes
 - o 1 Pilot LPO that has their own backend system
 - 1 Pilot LPO that uses only Rave (By Rave, we mean the CTSU pushes OPEN does to Rave)
- The caDSR Registry Steward is that curator who is working with the NRDS Content, i.e.
 Content Steward is Gwen Deen, overall caDSR may be Dianne Reeves

Discussion

- Ginger: We do not want a scenario where it is completed in one spot but the ALS document is not completed.
 - o Dianne: Where will the templates be housed?
 - o Ginger: They are shared on the collaboration portal on the CTSU website; they are currently denoted with a version but a date schema may sound good as well.
- Peter: I assume there is a process to ensure each LPO updates their Rave URL with the standard forms?
 - Neesha: Yes, the Policy WG has built a number of policies to ensure the LPOs have updated data

- CDE ID 2182728
 - Dose/Total dose of the investigational agent administered per course
 - Group wanted to change it into 2 questions: dose and total dose
- CDE ID 3028750
 - Unit of measure/dose minutes
 - Going to need 2 codes, dose from total dose the units can be different.
 - Does dose mean dose level? Dose, dose level, total dose

- Total dose total dose administered for that reporting period
- At Theradex there is usually only 1 instance for a course/cycle but can be more than one. They have a field called actual total dose but that corresponds to the singular dose and the calculated dose would be all the doses and they also have a planned dose level.
- Action Item: Dianne and Gwen to review the NCI standards and see what is in CDUS now to identify a comprehensive set of standards.

 - Update definition to take out AdEERs to NCI caAERS

 - Category Response
 - Use short text strings
 - Potentially add to this list

 - o Response Confirmed Date/ Response (observed date)
 - Angela the date of the best response will still be the date of the first response first confirmed
 - Depends on how you use the data
 - Include in the definition that this is based on how the protocol is written
