## NRDS Content Policy - Considerations

- Establish 'Balance of Powers' between WGs
- Policy WG to set general parameters on <u>scope</u> of Content WG
- Initially 'Guidance' and Broad
  - Will tighten as we learn

## NRDS content Policy - Macro

- ONLY standardize content that provides 'Value' to oncology community
- Value?
  - Integration; Science (primary; correlative; meta-analysis); Safety; Regulatory (CDISC); Efficiency (study build; site participants)
- Oncology Community
  - Patient; Site participants; data managers;
     study builders; statisticians; PIs; Group
     Leadership; NCI

#### NRDS Content Policy – Micro: Components

- Modules of CRFs
- Case Report Form
- Question
- User Value
- Coded Value

#### NRDS Content Policy – Micro: Guidelines

- Strive for content that contains all 5 components (ex. standard set of CRFs)
- May have a sub-set of selected standard CDEs that do NOT contain all 5 components
  - Common response: Yes, No, Other, Unknown
  - Evolving Science: Genomics Cancer Institute
