Overview

- Motivated by a need for better management and utilization of imaging data at the FDA
- Typically the observations are on CRFs while the images are on CDs — no good way to validate and verify
- 1. Provide ready access to source imaging data
- 2. Integrate with observations
- 3. Support federated query of images and observations

 - DICOM Images
 - AIM XML & SR annotations
- Data Sources
 - NBIA to store and manages DICOM studies
 - AIME to store and manage AIM XML & SR annotations

- Project Bindaas
 - Develop RESTful web services for data sources
 - Support server side data federation and federated queries
 - Convert data to browser aware formats
- NBIA
 - Manage DICOM studies
 - Potentially provide WADO service
- AIME
 - Manage AIM objects (XML and SR)
