## CDISC Submission Values that differ by case

- Had mU and MU in a GL for a while and this actually popped up in a study where Rave removed one during a publish & place
- Workaround: Avoid using the same coded value only differing by case in the same dictionary.
- NCI to look into this to see if there are implications with this scenario

#### Death Date is in DM domain in the NCI GLIB

- In SDTM this maps to the Demographics Domain
- This is more of a Disposition Domain
- Recommendation to move it to the DS Domains (DSSTDAT)

# Primary Cause of Death Response

- No data dictionary in CDISC for now
- Create a standardized list across the LPOs to use
- Examples: Tumor, new primary, drug related, unknown, other

### Off Treatment Intervention Reasons Code list

- The NCI required list is not inclusive of what the groups need. Our groups interested in performing a gap analysis and identify the missing values that can be used across groups?
- Alliance to advise to see if they are mapping the collected terms to the required CDUS values for reporting.

# Discuss OPEN Enrollment System

- The OPEN system does not provide information on failed criteria. It does provide information on criteria that passed for eligible patients.
- Per our CDISC SME, it is important to have that data if Sponsors or FDA Reviewers ask for it. This information is also universally useful. It's important to have that data and report it in SDTM format or have it available if organizations are asked for that information.
- CTSU will review this item.

### **LPO Questions**

### Group Discussion (Alliance Question)

- Concerned about the question text for the Off Treatment Reason/Off Study Reason being recommended as "Subject Status."
- I understand where this comes from in the disposition domain. Concerned about whether or not our sites will really get what this means. That is a very generic term – and we're asking a much more specific thing. Maybe it's just that it's so different from our existing terminology.
- Alliance: 1) Verify this question is CDUS related, and 2) to confirm if the concern is that the proposed CDISC text does not match the required CDUS text?

### **LPO Questions**

- Group Discussion (Alliance Question)
  - On the screening form, the CDASH Prompt is:
    - "Were all eligibility criteria met?" being the replacement for our current screening form.
    - Screening and eligibility as separate processes and don't think these are synonymous.
    - At Alliance we're likely not using the "Does the participant meet all screening criteria?" is the way the question reads.
    - Our actual purpose of this question is to track if the patient will continue onto the next step a data cleaning/reconciliation exercise.
    - How have other groups implemented the screening questions


