

## Workflow support

Welcome to the LexWiki Tutorial demo for WHO Hi-Ki platform where you will be viewing the Review Workflow process. Please note that within this demo it is assumed that you are a registered user and have logged in. Let's begin.

We will be walking through the next set of scenarios for reviewing proposals to ICD codes. We are going to return to the search menu to look for I42.0 Dilated Cardiomyopathy category.

We will be clicking on the Proposals tab and here you can see the proposals that have been made for this particular category by clicking on this specific proposal, you are directed to that proposal page and its own set of tabs.

You can see reason for change and the current Curation Status.

At this time we are going to leave a comment regarding this proposal and you can type that comment in the comment box provided. We will be submitting our comment by clicking on the Submit button.

If you would like to show the comments within the proposal, you click on the show button and you will see the comment. At this time we are going to browse our own personal proposals. Assuming you are logged in up at the very top right hand of your screen you will find my workflow.

Clicking on my workflow gives you a list of your task list of your proposals. You can review the task list of proposals in any workflow packages. My proposals are those proposals that you have created yourself. The proposals are organized by different curation statuses containing New Change, New Concept, New Removal, Rejected and Accepted proposals. Using this 'my workflow' page, users can easily access the proposals created by themselves.

If you are hoping to review all of the proposals you will find a link in the left navigation bar. Clicking on 'all proposals' will bring you to the Oncology browser.

Within our Oncology browser you see our workflow categorized by curation status. If you want a new change you see all the instances of proposals within this status. Clicking on a specific instance, you can bring up the attributes of that proposal.

You may also see the proposal based on chapter name.

By clicking on the left navigation bar ICD11 proposal, you can see the chapter names and by expanding the chapter names, here you can review all the proposals for that particular chapter.

You can click on the subcategory and drill into the proposals for each of the subsequent subcategories.

From here you can click on the proposals for that subcategory.

Clicking into that proposal will bring you back to the proposal page.

Returning to the left navigation bar there is a spot for feedback.

If you click this link you will be sent to the feedback form. Here you can fill in the form with your name, your email address and any comments you have regarding the use of Hi-Ki or the wiki area. When you click the Send comments button, the form will be sent directly to the LexWiki developers.
