

# 1 - Introduction - calIntegrator 1.4 or 1.4.x Installation

This *calIntegrator v.1.4 or 1.4.x Installation Guide* provides you with the instructions to install and configure a fresh calIntegrator v.1.4 or 1.4.x application. The calIntegrator installation installs and configures a JBoss application server and creates a calIntegrator-specific schema within a pre-existing database on a preinstalled MySQL server.

Directions are given in this document for both Linux and Windows operating systems. This page includes an overview of the installation.

## Overview of calIntegrator Installation

The process for installing calIntegrator v.1.4 or 1.4.x includes the following tasks described in this document:

1. Downloading and installing required software
2. Setting environment variables
3. Downloading calIntegrator v.1.4 or 1.4.x distribution files
4. Installing
  - a. GUI Installer Method
  - b. Command-Line Method
5. Configuring JBoss servers and MySQL server to run as a service
6. Post-Installation Tasks
  - a. Using UPT to Add calIntegrator Users



## Differences between v. 1.4 and 1.4.x

The only differences between installing 1.4 and 1.4.x are in upgrading the application. See the description in [Upgrading to calIntegrator 1.4.x](#). All other content in this installation guide applies to both versions 1.4 and 1.4.x.
