

# caArray 083 - Deleting the legacy files during caArray upgrade

Question: Can we delete the legacy files during caArray upgrade?

## Details about the Question

We are in the process of making a back up of our current installation of 2.1 for an impending upgrade to 2.3.1. There are some very large files in /jboss-4.0.4.GA/server/default/deploy/wsrf.war/WEB-INF/etc/cagrid\_TransferService/transferCache

Are these log files? Can we delete these files?

## Answer

The files in the directory are the related files related to the Transfer Service deployment. The service.properties file contains properties that can configure the Transfer Service in certain ways. If you change any of these properties you will need to redeploy the Transfer Service as described above and restart the container.

The property of **defaultTransferServiceContextTerminationTimeInMinutes** controls the default termination time that gets set on a transfer resource when it is created. The files can be removed if they are older than what is set for the **defaultTransferServiceContextTerminationTimeInMinutes** value.
