Using Wiki Markup Characters on a Page

When you are editing a wiki page, Confluence responds to some characters with autoformatting, as described in the following Atlassian help page:

However, you can also use those characters without autoformatting.

- 1. Type the character, such as an asterisk (*), or pair of characters, such as brackets ([]). Confluence responds with autoformatting.
- 2. Press Ctrl+Z. Confluence cancels the autoformatting, leaving behind only what you have typed.
- 3. Continue entering your text.

For example, we entered the following in this way:

[This is not a link.]
